ORDINANCE NO. 2016-O-7C

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 21.5, SIGNS, SEC. 21.5-13, VARIANCE; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 21.5-13 (a) of the Code of Ordinances, City of Angleton, Texas is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 21.5-13. – Variance

(a) A relaxation of the terms of this section may be permitted where such variance will not be contrary to the public interest and where, because of conditions peculiar to the property and as the result of the actions of the applicant, a literal enforcement of this section would result in unnecessary and undue hardship. A variance is authorized under this subsection only for height, sign area, freestanding sign or ground sign and length of time allowed to remove or to make conform a nonconforming sign.

SECTION 2. That if any provision, section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void, invalid, or unenforceable, the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or its application to other persons or sets of circumstances shall not be affected thereby, it being the intent of the City Council of the City of Angleton in adopting, and of the Mayor in approving this Ordinance, that no portion hereof or provision or regulation contained herein shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any unconstitutionality or invalidity of any portion, provision or regulation.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.

SECTION 4. That the City Council has found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance is considered is open to the public and that notice thereof was given in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, as amended, and that a quorum of the City Council was present.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and adoption.




