Addendum-Why Interested

Special interest in aquatic aspect of new proposed Anchor Rd Water Park and due diligence aspect of a project of this scope. I have been a member of the Heritage Oaks Lake Committee for ~10 yrs and a retired Dow Chemical Chemist. I still consider myself a Water Chemist as I worked as a water chemist for two years at a utility plant and another 5+ yrs at Dow on water related projects. Active member of the Brazoria County Coastal Conservation Association and former member of the Brazosport Garden Club so I have a special interest in the conservation and esthetics of such a project. I am also concerned about the liability aspect of the Anchor Rd lake open to the public as the Angleton Drainage District put the fence around the lake to prevent the kids from jumping their bikes into the lake. Ingress and egress to the lake would best be controlled off of Anchor Rd; however, the future widening of Anchor Rd must be factored into the parking and road access. I believe the project is doable over a longer period of time but not the 1-3 MM \$ project cited by RVI. Tax payers and voters need to be assured that the cost, maintenance of such a project is justified. Being retired, I will also have the time and interest to devote to the Angleton Parks Board.
