ORDINANCE NO. 5-05-2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS, DECLARING THAT THE CHARTER AMENDMENT APPROVED BY A MAJORITY OF THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY AT THE MAY 5, 2018, SPECIAL ELECTION IS ADOPTED; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a special election was held in the City of Angleton, Texas, on May 5, 2018, for the purpose of considering one or more amendments to the Home Rule Charter of the City of Angleton, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment, being the repeal of Section 8.29 of said charter, was approved by a majority of the qualified voters of the City who voted at said special election, as shown by the ordinance canvassing the results of said election attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9.005 of the Texas Local Government Code, a charter amendment does not take effect until the governing body of a municipality enters an order in the records of the municipality declaring that the amendment is adopted;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS:

Section 1. The amendment to the Home Rule Charter of the City of Angleton, Texas, approved by a majority of the qualified voters of the City who voted at the special election held on May 5, 2018, for the purpose of considering such amendment, being the repeal of Section 8.29 of said charter, is hereby adopted.

Section 2. Section 8.29 of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Angleton, Texas, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas, hereby enters this order into its records.

Section 4. *Severability.* In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Angleton, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.

Section 5. *Effective date.* This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

COMPLIANCE WITH OPEN MEETINGS ACT

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was considered was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.
