1. **Call to order** 5:36 p.m.
2. **KAB Members Present:** Andrea Demopulos-Coats, Brandei Goolsby, Dorothy Wilbeck, John Wright, Williams Tigner
Staff Present: Erin Bowers
Visitors Present: Pam Davis, Lisa Kitzner
3. **Approval of December Minutes**
Motion by Brandei Goolsby to approve the minutes; second by John Wright
Motion passes 4 for, 0 against, 1 absent
4. **Visitor comments:** Pam Davis is the Elementary Director for AISD. She said there were several teachers trained in WIP. When they finished the training they pulled the curriculum apart and set aside different curriculum for each grade level. They would like to get a WIP book for every grade level at each elementary school campus.
5. **Standing Committee Reports:**
 - a. **Recycling & Litter Prevention**
 - b. **Beautification**
 - i. Neighborhood beautification
Code Enforcement is working on a list of areas that really need beautification.
 - ii. Art and Sculpture Contest
Dorothy Wilbeck said that she talked to the Angleton High School Art Club a few years ago and that they would be willing to do it for free if KAB provided the paint.
 - c. **Education**
 - i. Waste in Place Curriculum
AISD requested 18 WIP with the additional books and 12 without the additional books. This total is \$1200.00. Pam Davis said that right now, each school has one book. In order to implement the curriculum effectively, it would be best if each grade level at each campus had the curriculum. Lisa Kitzner stated that AISD will barcode each book to keep track of them. The board discussed how KAB could pay for this initiative. The topic was tabled for next meeting pending further budget information from staff.
 - d. **Community Awareness**
 - i. Heart Dedication
Brandei Goolsby created a subcommittee and will start planning this event. Board discussed ideas for the event. Brandei Goolsby suggested a wine and cheese event at Texas 100. John Wright suggested making plaques of what downtown used to look like and how it has come along and also to bring out the original project board. Brandei Goolsby suggested having volunteer tour guides that walk downtown with guests and give the history.
6. **Staff Items**
 - a. **2016 Event Calendar**
Board discussed a possible Arbor Day Event.
 - b. **Budget Update**
Double sided Yard and Business of the Month signs were \$90.00. Keep Texas Beautiful 2016 Affiliate dues were \$100.00.
 - c. **Open Board Position/Board Member Recruitment**
Andrea Demopulos-Coats has recruited a new board member, Tracy Delesandri. Cheryl Scarborough has an interested candidate, Susan Dellinger. Neither has turned in their applications yet.
 - d. **February Board Meeting**
Board would like to further discuss the neighborhood beautification project and Arbor Day

projects.

e. Other Discussion Items

AISD also requested recycle bins for each classroom from staff. Staff is currently looking for grants that would make it possible to make this purchase.

Staff updated board that KAB received 250 paper bags from Kroger and HEB. Those 500 bags will be given to Pam Davis and she will distribute between schools for an Earth Day project.


