THE CITY COUNCIL OF ANGLETON, TEXAS CONVENED IN A REGULAR MEETING ON TUESDAY, MAY 14, 2019, AT 6:00 P.M. IN THE ANGLETON CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS, 120 S. CHENANGO, ANGLETON, TEXAS.

15. Discussion and possible action regarding a street closure for a Juneteenth Community Celebration. (Katherine Davis)

Upon a motion by Mayor pro-tem Wright and seconded by Council Member Booth, Council approved the street closure 12:00 PM - 9:00 PM. for the Juneteenth Community Celebration on 326 N. Erskine and to have the applicant hire 2 off-duty, licensed police officers and to have staff arrange trash pick-up. The motion passed on a 6-0 vote.

16. Discussion and possible action on Ordinance No. 20190514-016 amending the budget for FY 2018-19. (Susie Hernandez)

The motion passed on a 6-0 vote.
