



## PARKS & RECREATION SERVICE PROJECTS

- Increase beautification around park signs
- Develop a geocaching program in the area and then turn the program over to Angleton Parks and Recreation for any future program management needs (updates, checking, etc.)
- Build nest houses or bird boxes and mount them in designated parks and along Hike/Bike Trail:

- Plant approved nectar and host plants to attract butterflies in approved locations
- Fundraise to purchase new park benches
- Manage an educational booth at a special event
- Cut/Grind tree stumps
- Replace deck boards on Parks trailers and repaint them
- Develop programs and/or marketing materials for the purposes of environmental education
- Plant trees throughout walking paths and parks
- Complete a tree survey at specified parks
- Remove underbrush and raise tree canopy at specified parks
- Remove invasive plants in the designated parks
- Raise funds for dog park amenities
- Clean up and walking trails at city parks
- Trim tree suckers in city parks and facilities
- Assist with plant removal and landscaping at city parks and facilities
- Plant butterfly garden in approved park areas
- Host conservation classes at the Recreation Center (i.e. wetland, Monarch Butterfly, etc.)
