THE FOLLOWING REPRESENTS THE ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE ANGLETON CITY COUNCIL IN THE ORDER THEY OCCURRED DURING THE MEETING. THE CITY COUNCIL OF ANGLETON, TEXAS CONVENED IN A REGULAR MEETING ON TUESDAY, JUNE 16, 2020, AT 6:00 P.M., IN THE ANGLETON CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS, 120 S. CHENANGO, ANGLETON, TEXAS.

DECLARATION OF A QUORUM AND CALL TO ORDER

With a quorum present, Mayor Perez called the Council Meeting to order at 6:02 P.M., Mayor Perez, Mayor pro-tem Wright, Council Member Booth, Council Member Gongora, and Council Member Svoboda were present.

Council Member Booth led the invocation.

CONSENT AGENDA

The following items were acted on by one motion.

2. Discussion and possible action on awarding Hotel Occupancy Tax Funding to Peach Street Farmers Market Night Jams Event in the amount of \$3,000 and Brazoria County Fair Association for the 2020 Brazoria County Fair in the amount of \$10,000.
Upon a motion by Mayor pro-tem Wright and seconded by Council Member Booth, Council awarded Hotel Occupancy Tax Funding to Peach Street Farmers Market Night Jams Event in the amount of \$3,000 and Brazoria County Fair Association for the 2020 Brazoria County Fair in the amount of \$10,000. 5. Discussion and possible action on Resolution No. 20200623-005 accepting the invitation of the Commissioner’s Court of Brazoria County to join the Gulf Coast Transit District (GCTD) and authorizing the transfer of the existing interlocal agreement for the provision of public transit services for the City from the Gulf Coast Center to the GCTD.
Upon a motion by Mayor pro-tem Wright and seconded by Council Member Gongora, Council approved Resolution No. 20200623-005. The motion passed on a 5-0 vote.
6. Discussion and possible action on an Interlocal Contract Amendment with Gulf Coast Center to join the Gulf Coast Transit District (GCTD), a new Bi-County Transit District, to provide public transit services within Galveston and Brazoria counties and transfer the Interlocal Contract Agreement with the GCC to the GCTD.
Upon a motion by Mayor pro-tem Wright and seconded by Council Member Gongora, Council approved an Interlocal Contract Amendment with Gulf Coast Center to join the Gulf Coast Transit District (GCTD). The motion passed on a 5-0 vote.
7. Discussion of services provided by Buxton Company.
Presentation was made by Robb Miller of Buxton Company.

8. Discussion and possible action to award the construction contract for the Southside 0.75 MG Elevated Storage Tank Replacement.
Upon a motion by Mayor pro-tem Wright and seconded by Council Member Booth, Council awarded the contraction contract to Landmark Structures. The motion passed on a 5-0 vote.
9. Discussion and possible action on a concert in Welch Park during a time of COVID-19.
10. Discussion and possible action on Governor Abbott executive orders to date and Brazoria County emergency declarations and impact on the City of Angleton and how to proceed with city business in the future.
