Narrative

During the months of November and December 2020, the City of Angleton and surrounding jurisdictions experienced an unusual increase of vehicle burglaries. These vehicle burglaries were sporadic throughout the city during this time and other cities, including Clute, Lake Jackson, and Richwood experienced similar criminal activity.

Angleton Police Department Criminal Investigations Unit worked diligently to identify the suspect responsible for these burglaries and seek justice for the victims. Angleton Police Detectives collaborated with Lake Jackson Police Department, Clute Police Department, Freeport Police Department, and Richwood Police Department during this investigation. Angleton Police Department also sought help from citizens through social media outlets by posting images of the suspect committing the burglaries.

In early January 2021, Angleton Police Detectives were able to make a break in the case and identified Major Gilmore III (DOB: 10/06/1999) as the suspect. The Angleton Police Department issued 16 arrest warrants, which cleared 14 total cases for burglary of motor vehicle and theft of a firearm. Gilmore III was placed in custody on January 24, 2021 by the Brazoria County Sheriff's Office and was transported to the Brazoria County Sheriff's Office Jail without incident.
