## **Narrative**

On January 8, 2021, the Angleton Police Department responded to an aggravated robbery at 2851 North Downing Street (Food Mart #3), Angleton, Texas. Upon arrival of officers, the suspect had left the store on foot and was not located. An initial investigation found that an unknown suspect entered the store, demanded money while holding a weapon, assaulted the cashier, and left with a large amount of money.

Angleton Police Department Criminal Investigations Unit diligently worked on this case, following up on several leads and tips provided by citizens. Angleton Police Detectives collaborated with the Freeport Police Department, who had also had an aggravated robbery, which occurred in the same manner and in the same timeframe. Angleton Detectives were able to identify the suspect as Armoni Williams (DOB: 12/05/2003). Angleton Police Department issued an arrest warrant on Armoni Williams for Aggravated Robbery, which is a 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Felony.

The U.S. Marshals Service-Gulf Coast Violent Offenders Task Force and Houston Police Department assisted and were able to place Williams in custody today, January 27, 2021, at approximately 3:00 PM in Houston, Texas. Angleton Detectives took custody of Williams and transported him to the Angleton Police Department, where he was booked into jail for the Aggravated Robbery arrest warrant.
