Narrative

On January 8, 2021, at 6:18 AM, Angleton Police Department was requested at 2851 North Downing Street (Food Mart #3), Angleton, Texas in reference to an aggravated robbery with a weapon. Prior to arrival, the suspect had left the store on foot. Officer's searched the area but were unable to locate the suspect. An initial investigation found that an unknown suspect entered the store, demanded money while holding a weapon, assaulted the cashier, and left with a large amount of money. Officers secured the area and the public is not in any immediate danger at this time. The suspect is described as a Black male, thin build, and approximately 5'8"-6'00" tall. The suspect was wearing a black hoodie covered with a gray Champion brand sweatshirt, black pants, and black shoes.
