



FUTURE PARK DEVELOPMENT Survey Questions & Summaries

A survey regarding Future Park Development was posted electronically from September 3 – September 30, 2021. Seventy-nine (79) people took the survey and below is a listing of questions and summarized results.

Park on the South Side of Town

Many City properties on the south side of town are not easily accessible to our residents. In efforts to better plan for the future, consideration may be given to acquiring additional land, no less than five acres, to develop a park on the southside of town. If that were to occur, the City would like your input.

Please keep in mind when completing this survey, our minimum park standards for new development include sidewalks along street frontage, all utilities, LED lighting along the street and within the park, wireless network infrastructure, a restroom facility, one playscape structure (or other comparable amenities may be provided such as basketball courts, outdoor exercise stations or splash pads), covered picnic tables, grills, and trash containers, drinking fountain, and park benches. Minimally, these elements will be included in new park development.

Note: Location for a new park the south side of town has not been determined. Please answer this survey as if a location has been determined.

Results:

- Most individuals would use this park for walking, exercise, play, family activities, biking, and playground and splash pad use
- Most individuals think citizens of all ages would use the park
- Top five park amenities desired are a playground for (5-12), trails, splash pad, playground (2-5), and swings
- If there was sidewalk connectivity, individuals would most likely bike or walk
- If there was not sidewalk connectivity, individuals would most likely drive a car
- The Park would be used most likely on the weekend or during the week at various times
- 78% of respondents would like a splash pad at this park

Municipal Pool Site

The municipal pool was recently demolished in preparation for future park development. The municipal pool site is a small two-acre parcel with Dwyer bisecting the land leaving about an acre that can be used for park elements including parking. The Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Master and Strategic Plan provided the following suggestions:

ACTION 3.4.A. - Conduct feasibility study to improve outdoor water access in the city. This could include updates to existing outdoor pool location or other potential properties. (Short to midterm) Municipal Pool - Assessed as "Totally Unusable" Replace Municipal pool with splash pad Outdoor water access is lacking, and this can be addressed through a possible renovation of



the outdoor municipal pool into a splash pad or the establishment of splash pads in key areas such as the South side of the city and the Recreation Center.

Results:

- A majority of respondents would like to see this site used for park development
- Top three park amenity ideas include splash pad, playground (5-12), and playground (2-5)
- 74% of respondents are in favor of this site being a special use park for something like a skate park
- A majority of respondents are not in favor of selling this property
- If there was sidewalk connectivity, individuals would most likely bike or walk

Veterans Park Redevelopment

Livable Centers are defined as places where people can live, work, and play with less reliance on their cars. Studies often provide suggestions to communities revolved around improving infrastructure, policies, and programs to be more multi-modal friendly. In early 2021, the City of Angleton adopted a Livable Centers Study that focused on the downtown corridor that stretches from the railroad track to Millers Street between Loop 274 and Arcola. The following action items were identified for Veterans Park:

ACTION 4. - Expand and Enhance Veterans Park

4.1. - Acquire additional land to expand the park into the existing parking lot west of Veterans Park using Angleton better Living Corporation (ABLC) and/or other funding.

4.2. - Retain a landscape architect to conduct a needs assessment and prepare a programming plan.

4.3. - Conduct community engagement to determine programming needs for the park.

Additionally, on June 14, 2021, the Parks and Recreation Board noted food trucks, a gazebo or amphitheater structure, and art were program elements needed for the park. A preliminary concept has been developed to include picnic seating, open space, amphitheater/stage and restroom facility structure, food truck hookups, a dedicated Veterans memorial, and interactive water feature.

Results:

- Respondents would like to see the park used for food trucks, concerts, events, family activities, and picnics
- The Park would be used most likely on the weekend or during the week at various times
- 82% of respondents are more likely to use the park if ample seating was provided

Officer Cash Memorial Dog Park Redevelopment

The City of Angleton's dog park is located between Anderson and Kiber. The Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Master and Strategic Plan identified improvements that were needed including:



ACTION 3.8.a - Consider improvements to the current dog park areas: Entrance/access (new location away from shelter/south side along Kiber Street), Additional features (shade structures, trees, etc.), Add water source for dogs, Parking, Other areas to enhance park

ACTION 3.8.b - Consider a Master Plan to locate a second park and take the opportunity to plan with input from dog park users.

Results:

- 75% of 59 respondents were dog owners
- Size of a dog park ranged from 1-5 acres
- 83% of 55 respondents prefer large and small dogs to be separated
- The top five dog park amenities included shade, dog drinking fountains, walking trail, wash stations, and an interactive water feature
- Preference for a stand-alone dog park and dog park incorporated into a larger park was nearly split 50.00% to 49.12% accordingly
- Monday is the preferred closure day for dog park maintenance

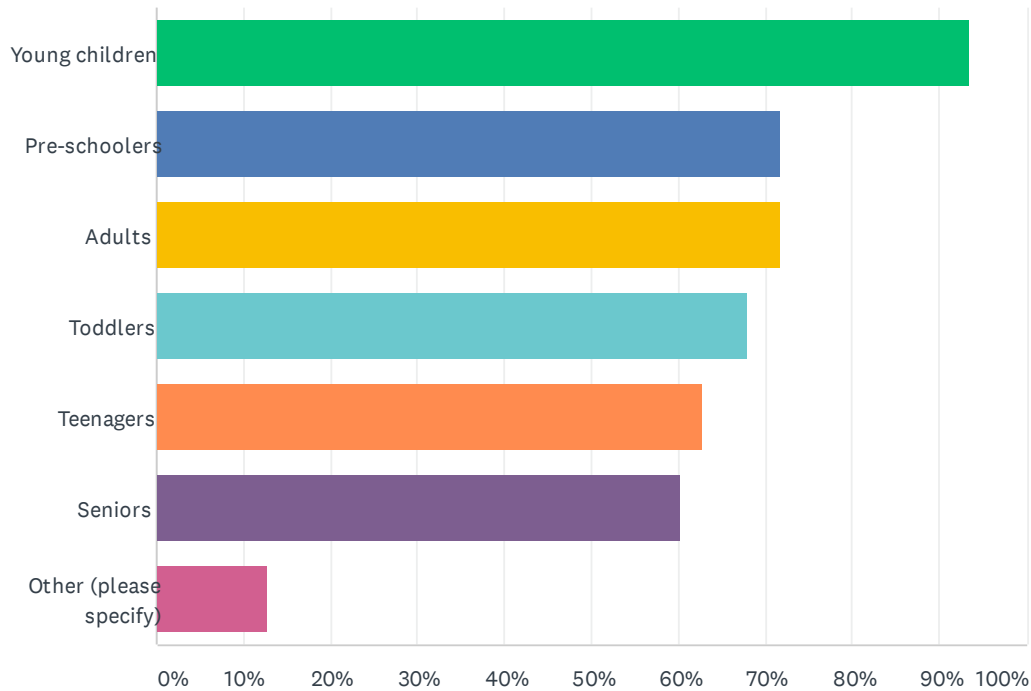

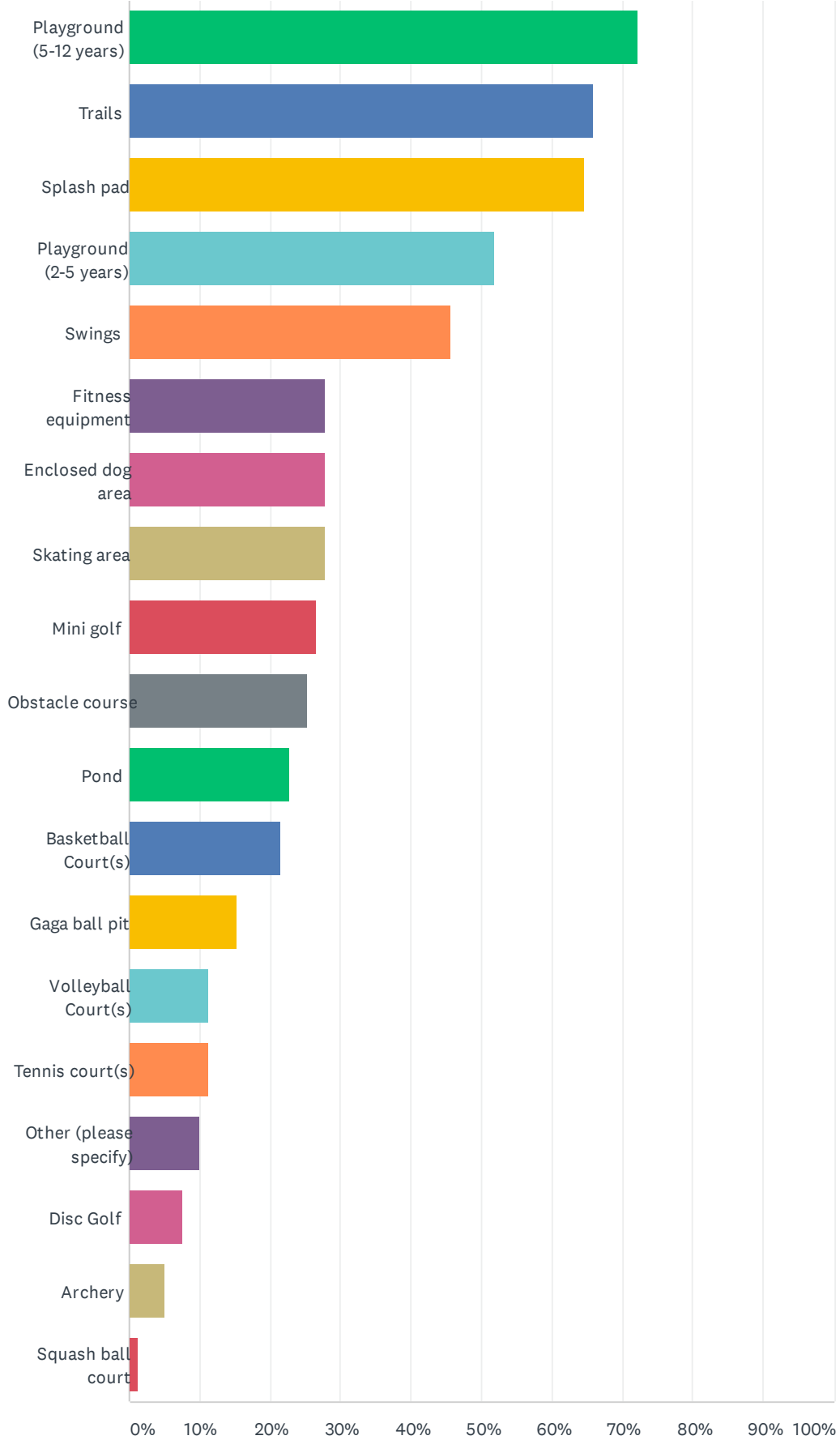

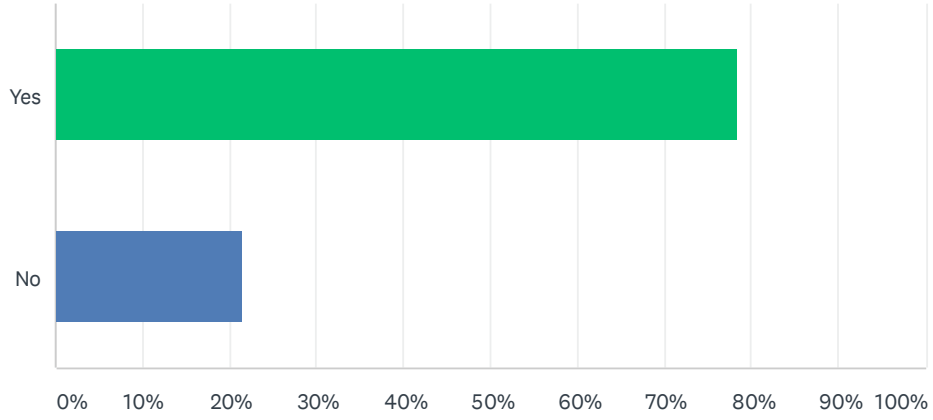

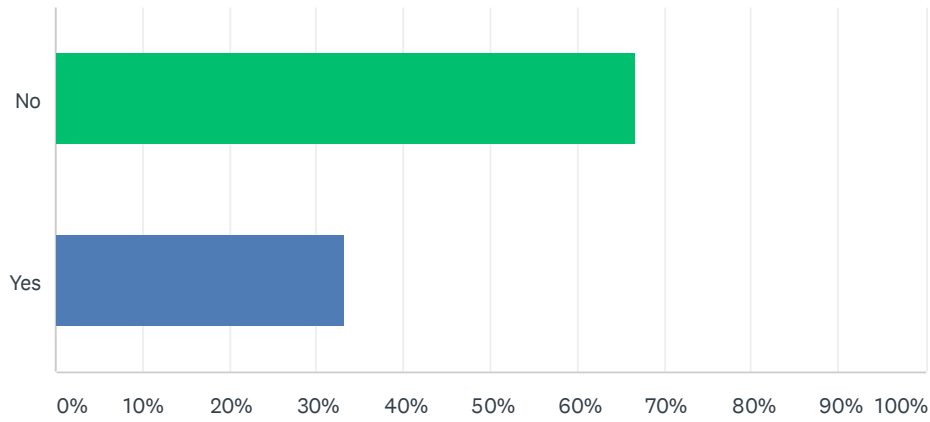

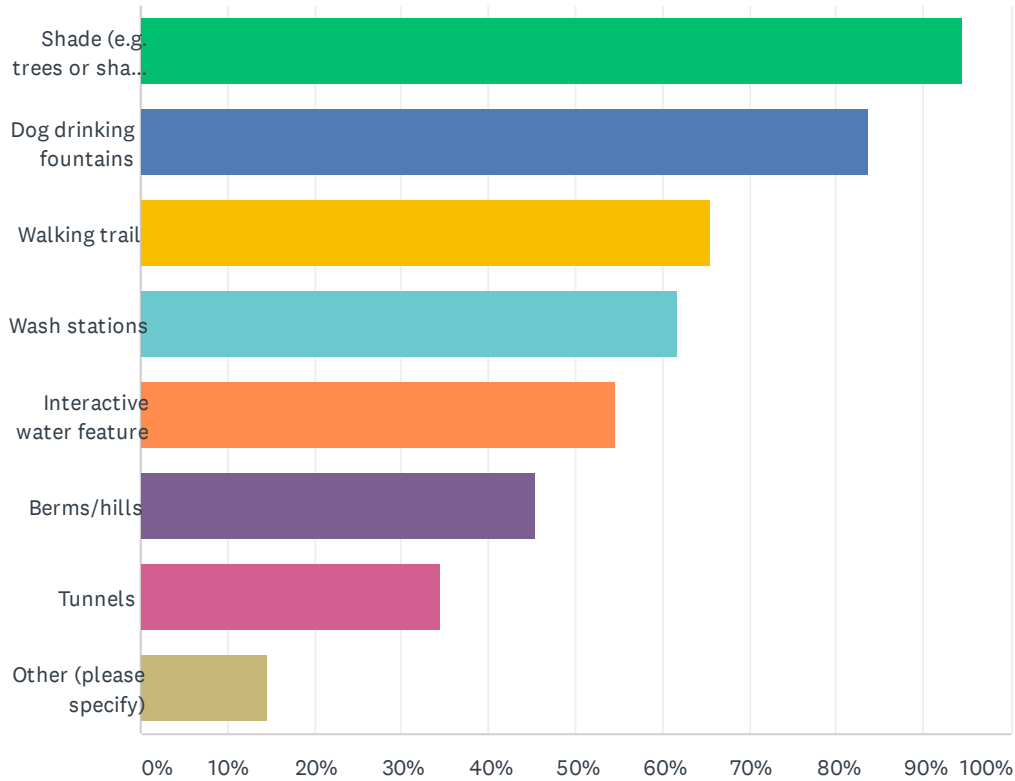

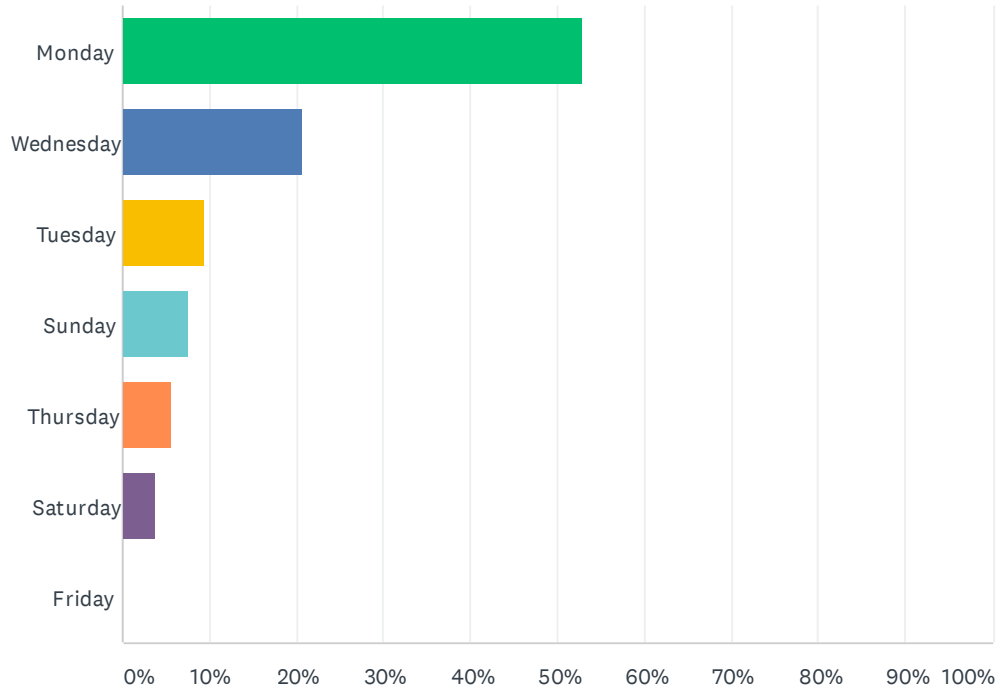
