Narrative

On Monday, September 12, 2022, at approximately 1:54 pm, Angleton Police Department was dispatched to the 700 block of North Parrish Street in reference to a subject waving a gun around and threatening people in the area. The 911 caller stated that the male subject left the area in a Ford F150 that was stolen. Angleton Police Officers located the described vehicle nearby and attempted to make a traffic stop. The gray Ford F150 failed to yield and evaded from the officers, who were in marked police vehicles. While evading, the suspect vehicle struck another uninvolved vehicle and continued. The pursuit ended when the suspect vehicle wrecked in the northwest corner of the intersection of FM 523 and State Highway 288-Business. The driver of the vehicle, identified as Kevin Wright (18-year-old male), who was the only occupant, exited the vehicle and displayed a pistol. Wright began evading on foot and was chased by Angleton Police Officers. Officers gave commands for Wright to drop the weapon and Wright then dropped the pistol in the roadway. Wright was taken into custody and transported to the Angleton Police Department, where he was booked in for Unauthorized use of a motor vehicle, duty on striking fixture, accident involving damage >\$200, terroristic threat, unlawfully carrying of weapon, and evading arrest/detention in a vehicle.
