Narrative

Update:

On September 27, 2022, Angleton Criminal Investigation Division identified a suspect in this hit and run fatality case. Detectives located the suspects' vehicle, a gray 2012 Toyota Tundra, which had damage to the front end. Detectives interviewed and arrested Haydn Dean Muirheid (21-year-old White male) for accident involving death, which is a 2nd Degree Felony. Muirheid was transported to the Angleton Police Department and is currently being held on an \$80,000.00 bond. Although we have made an arrest, this is still an ongoing investigation.

Original:

On Friday, September 23, 2022, at approximately 2:10 am, Angleton Police Department received a 911 call that there was a deceased person in the roadway in the area of South Velasco Street and Cemetery Road in Angleton, Brazoria County, Texas. Upon arrival, Angleton Officers located a deceased subject in the roadway described as a White male who appeared to be in his mid-40s. Angleton Criminal Investigations Division responded and began their investigation. Investigators determined that the victim was struck by an unidentified dark-colored pickup truck, which then fled the scene. Investigators are still gathering video evidence from surrounding businesses in the vicinity and working to identify more witnesses. At this time, the victim has not been positively identified. We received assistance from the Brazoria County Sheriff's Office and the Texas Department of Public Safety. Due to the nature of the investigation, all northbound and southbound lanes of travel were closed on South Velasco Street at Cemetery Road, and traffic was diverted. The roadway was shut down for approximately five hours. This is an active investigation, and we will release further details as the investigation develops.
